## Membership Information

### 2008 Membership Dues - \$85.00 (\$75.00 plus \$10.00 Hole in One)

1. An award for a hole in one will not be presented until the Awards Banquet at the end of the season. A hole in one counts only in an official men's club event. If more than one hole-in-one is scored, the pot will be divided by the number made during the season. All other monies collected will be distributed back to the players in prize and food, except for \$150.00 in seed money for the following year.
2. There will be 25 tournaments; all scheduled for Sundays. See attached schedule. Your membership fee includes the end of the year banquet and 2 nights of bar tickets.
3. For all to play in our Calcutta, prior to Calcutta, a minimum of six scores must be posted. There will be a fee of \$66.00 for each event. This includes golf/cart and prizes. All members must use a cart.
4. Any rain out or days when carts are not allowed on the course, will count as one event for all members. The board must call the rain out.
5. We will play in three flights; A, B, and C. Membership will be divided at each handicap posting. Your handicap can move up or down at event. Your bracket will be used for the Club Championship. Your actual handicap will be used in determining your net score in all tournaments. The maximum handicap is 32. (A) is 0/13, (B) is 14/19; and (C) is 20/32. Club championship is to be decided between class A, B, and C at full handicap. First qualifying round will be your class throughout the Club Championship for new members. New members must have a minimum of 5 scores to qualify.
6. Skins: \$10.00. Scratch: \$10.00. Handicap will be an option during each event. Another option is \$5.00 closet-to-the-pin on two par 3's. You may play any or none of the options. New members will not be eligible to play in handicap skins until they have played 5 men's club events. However, they are allowed to play in the scratch skins starting in their first event.
7. Match play game (individual) fee is \$10.00 for each round. More details on tournament sheet. A minimum of 16 players are needed for match play. 1 bye. Existing members only. \$10.00 due at sign-up.
8. U.S.G.A. and local rules will govern all events. You will receive rules sheet at the beginning of the season. Minimum net score on any hole is one. An actual play off will be used to break first place ties in the Club Championship, match play finals, and Calcutta. All other ties will be drawn backwards off score cards. A minimum of 6 games must be played to be eligible for the "clean out the pot" event. We will have the father, son or daughter event on Father's Day.
9. There is a bulletin board in the men's locker room with scores and the latest breaking news. Cash prizes will be awarded at the end of the year banquet for class A, class B, and class C Championship and Club Championship. The hole in one and the match play cash prizes will also be awarded.
10. You must turn in your scores promptly after each event. The committee wants to complete its job as soon as possible so everyone can go to the bar or go home. The committee may change any rule, if necessary, at any time. The course has front, middle, and back tees. We will play all our games from the white tees. All members 72 and over will use RED tees. We play the gold course, except for the last Sunday of the month. Then we play the Blue course.
11. You may play with whomever you want or we will be glad to make a foursome for you. Certain games you must play with group drawn for event.
